Only a short time ago, Steve was diagnosed with stage 4 small cell carcinoma of the brain, liver, lung and bone. This form of cancer is very aggressive. Due to the location of the cancer, the initial radiation and chemotherapy treatments have been focused on his neck and brain. It was found that the cancer has consumed 2 of his cervical vertebrae. He has been placed in a neck brace until surgery can be performed, which will have to wait until he has completed his radiation and chemotherapy treatments.

In spite of his pain, Steve has kept up his spirits and is very positive toward his recovery. Undergoing this treatment will challenge Steve physically and his family financially. All proceeds from this event will go directly to his family for medical care. As you may imagine, the medical bills are astronomical, thus the reason for the benefit.
